Open enrollment for new teams April 9^{th.} 6:00 PM Single golfers who participated last year have preference. We may ask teams to switch divisions to accommodate all teams. In the event that we have more than the maximum number of teams in a division, there will be a lottery amongst the new teams. <u>MEMBERS DUES MUST BE PAID IN FULL OR PARTICIAPTING IN A MCC DUES PAYMENT</u>

Divisions:

Early Division – Maximum of 20 Teams Late Division – Maximum of 20 Teams

League Starts 4/28/2020 League Ends 9/8/2020

<u>From 4:00 – 4:30 there will be an overlap between divisions to tee off. Late Division teams</u> will be allowed to tee off beginning at 4:00 PM if all golfers are present. However, early division teams have a preference on the tee, and will move to the beginning of the tee sheet when all golfers are present. <u>ALL GOLFERS MUST BE PRESENT AT THE PRO SHOP TO PUT YOUR TEAMS ON THE</u> <u>STARTERS LIST.</u>

Rules of Engagement:

There will be two 10 week seasons Matches will be in 4 ball format (best of 2 balls), played over 9 holes.

75% Tuesday League Handicaps for all players. All stroke off the lowest handicap golfer.

Scoring:

Each hole is worth 2 points

Maximum amount of points for 9 hole match is 18 points

Halved holes are worth 1 point for each team

Player Substitutions:

All Tuesday Night League participants are encouraged to make a commitment to playing their matches on Tuesday Night. Postponements due to absenteeism should be kept to a minimum. In the event that a team of two is not able to be present for a Tuesday Night match, the following options are available:

- 1. <u>Reschedule the match at a time agreed upon by both teams within one week of</u> <u>postponed match. If the match is not made up by the next week, cards will be</u> <u>matched during the match the next week after not playing. NO EXCEPTIONS</u>
- 2. Reschedule the match earlier than scheduled at a time agreed upon by both teams.
- 3. Secure a substitute from the member substitute lists posted in Pro Shop and 19th Hole Grille, and play match on originally scheduled date with a sub.
- 4. If a team does not play a match for two consecutive weeks, that team is disqualified from the league for the year. No refunds for disqualified teams.

Players are asked to commit to this league and play your matches when scheduled.

<u>Substitutes:</u>

MCC member in good standing with a current GHIN card Can't be a team member of either division Must have at least one team member present or match must be rescheduled.

A sub list will be posted in the pro shop and on the web site. Please make use of subs.

In case of an issue involving a team that needs another player for an extended period of time due to unforeseen circumstances or injury, the tournament committee or their designee can determine a suitable permanent sub.

Schedule:

Team play schedule posted in pro shop and 19th hole. Matches may be played prior to scheduled match, if conflicts occur.

Rain out/lightening (closed course) matches must be made up within 1 week. Check with pro for available tee times

Suspended play will resume after the last completed hole when play is called.

Matches can be made up for any reason but MUST be done within original 1 week time frame.

Players must notify pro shop on day of scheduled match to let them know if you are using a sub, rescheduling the match, or playing the match on an earlier date than originally scheduled.

ALL FIRST HALF MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE LAST TUESDAY OF THAT SEASON, JUNE 30th.

ALL SECOND HALF MATCHES MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE LAST TUESDAY OF THAT SEASON, SEPTEMBER 8th.

Any un-played matches will result in a score of 9-9.

Forfeits:

If a team does not show up for league play, and does not notify either the Pro Shop or the opposing team, the result of that match will be a forfeit. The team that is at the course ready to play has the choice to accept or decline the forfeit. The score for a forfeited match will be 10-0.

Handicap Policy

The Pro Shop will prepare Tuesday Night League scorecards prior to Tuesday match play. Scorecards can be obtained in the Pro Shop. Member handicaps will be obtained weekly using a specific Tuesday League Handicap. We will no longer use your GHIN handicap for the Tuesday League. Only scores posted during a Tuesday League match will be used in calculating your Tuesday League handicap.

Handicaps 19 and under, maximum score allowed on any hole is a double bogey. Handicaps 20 and over, maximum score allowed on any hole is a triple bogey.

Any member joining the league without an official handicap should post a minimum of three 9 hole scores to the pro shop prior to the start of league play. Handicap Committee will then assign a handicap for the first week of the league. If three 9 hole scores are not submitted, the new member will start as a 10 and adjusted after future Tuesday League scores are submitted. The scorecard must be signed by another member in good standing.

Any complaints of handicap or rules violations will be handled by the pro shop, tournament committee, or handicap committee. Once a person's score has been conceded, take the score at that point within reason. If your putt is conceded on the green, you cannot putt out until after the hole has been determined if time allows. (Pace of Play)

Playoff and Prizes:

The league will consist of two 10 week seasons. There will be no playoffs at the conclusion of the league season.

Prizes will be awarded to the top 4 teams in each division, for each 10 weak season.

At the conclusion of the first 10 weeks, all teams will reset and start the 2nd season at 0-0.

Tiebreaker is years head to head scoring. If still tied, then best point total against highest other position in the division If still tied, there will be a 9 hole playoff

Complaints

Any complaints including but not limited too; handicap, conduct, or pace of play must be reported to the pro shop as soon to the incident occurs within a reasonable time. If a complaint/rule violation cannot be solved by team members in a professional and respectful matter on the spot, the complaint can be directed to the Pro Shop/proper committee. Remember....we are out here to have fun and enjoy each other's company!
